Our Carry Partners

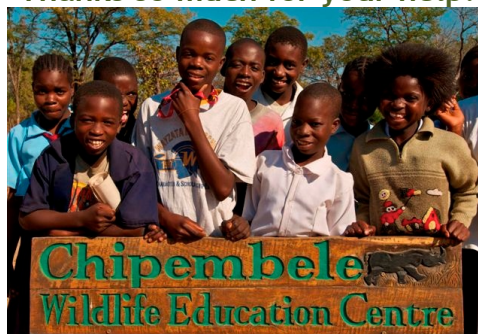
Chipembele has partnered with several traveller's carry organisations, if you would prefer to make your carry-in donation by liaising with them please do!
